Status of Consent to Establish from KSPCB: We have obtained consent to establish vide no.PCB/HO/EE2/EKM/ICE/18/2016 dated 12.07.16 for Laying of LPG pipeline from Puthuvypeen import terminal to Kochi Refinery in Kerala.

KSPPL Project status: The terminal construction activity at Puthuvypeen by M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) is on hold due to Public agitation. Kochi Salem Pipeline is planning to commence the pipeline laying activities from this terminal to Kochi Refinery along with the development of terminal construction by IOCL.

iii)	The Ministry reserves the right to revoke this clearance if any of the conditions stipulated are not complied with the satisfactio0n of the Ministry.	Noted.
iv)	In the event of a change in project profile or change in the implementation agency, a fresh reference shall be made to the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate change.	Noted.

Construction of import terminal is presently suspended due to severe resistance by the local public citing certain CRZ violations and other demands.  The financial closure is achieved on 25.05.2015
